# Mt.Fuji Climbing Route 3776



"Mt. Fuji Climbing Route 3776" is the unique and challenging route in which you can aim the summit of Mt. Fuji from the sea level. This route is 42km (26miles) long and 3,776m(12,388 feet) high. If you reach the summit collecting stamps during the route, you will get a commemorative gift.

- Using gas burners or similar equipment around the mountain hut may causes fires. Please refrain from using them.
- Resting is not allowed inside the mountain hut.

Fuji-Tsukenaporitan is a local food in Fuji City. That food is mix of neapolitan spaghetti and tsukemen, dipping ramen. You dip the noodle into tomato-based soup like tsukemen. Each restaurantes have thier own soup and noodle. How about finding the best Fuji-Tsukenaporitan for you?

### Fujinomiya Yakisoba

Fujinomiya Yakisoba is one of the best local food in Japan. This fried noodle is more chewy than general noodles. In addition, we stir-fly fried pork with cabbege, and put shaved dried sardine for topping. You must be addicted to its Umami taste and chewy noodles. You should try it!!

You normaly eat roasted peanuts, but in our area we eat boiled and solted peanuts as a custom. In Fujinomiya City, we have many farms of peanuts, and some of them cultivate "Jumbo peanut", which is twice as big as normal one. Let's enjoy drinking with boild peanuts.


## Unique toilet paper



## Climbing Mt.Fuji ~Fujinomiya Trail~ Climbig Season: from 10th July to 10th Sep

Fujinomiya trail is historic and known as a "front door" of Mt.Fuji from a long time ago. This is the shortest of four trails, and you can enjoy panoramic view of the ocean. We recommend watching sunrise or visiting Kengamine Peak, the highest point in Japan. At the top of Mt. Fuji, there is a shirine and a post office. You can buy amulets and send letters to your family.

## Climbing Precautions





- Avoid Bullet Climbing.
  "Bullet Climbing" Climbing without rest can significantly increases risks of injury or illness.
   We recommend two days and one night climbing.
- Be careful for falling rocks.
- Please take your trash with you when you leave.
- Keep the toilets and other public facilities clean.
- As a general rule climbers descending the mountain are expected to give way to climbers ascending.
- Please lower your voice in and around huts.
- The following acts are prohibited by law in the designated area.
  - 【Removing animals,plants,lava and rocks from the mountain / Pitching a tent / Making a fire / Releasing pets, etc. / Sowing or planting seeds.】
- Confirm necessary equipment for the climbing before departure. Don't underestimate the risks involved with climbing Mt.Fuji or take it lightly. Insufficient preparation is dangerous and may result in injuries or accidents.
